

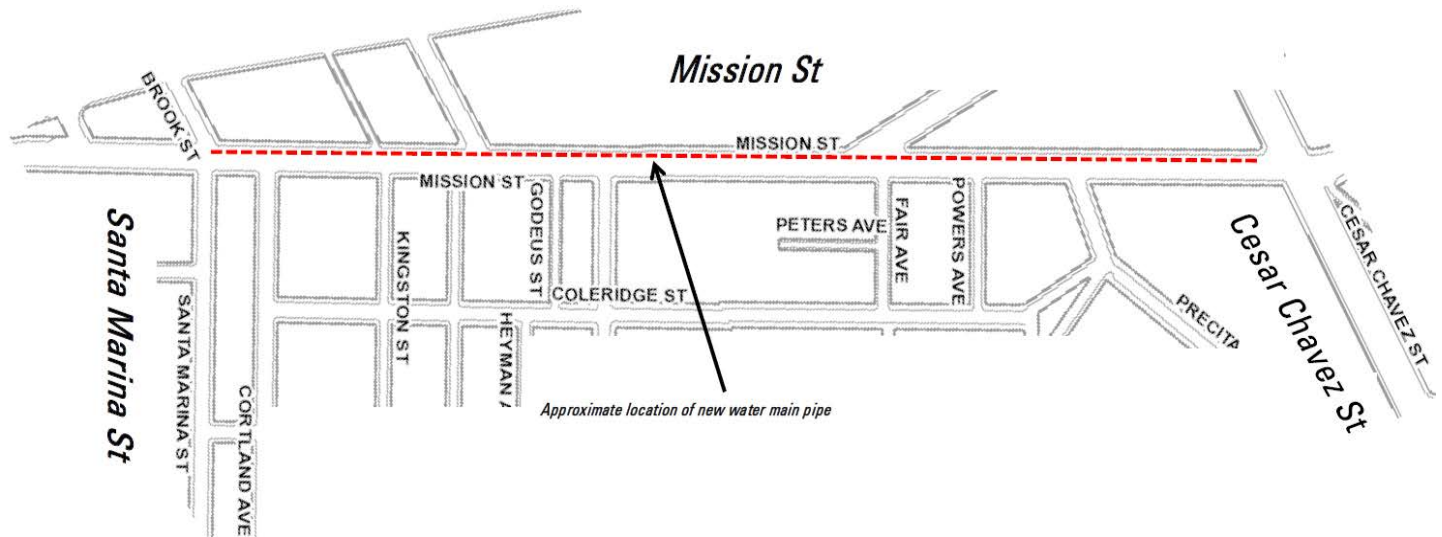


## Water Main Replacement and Pavement Renovation Project – Mission Street (WD-2667)

**Project Description:** The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) and the Department of Public Works (DPW) have partnered to expedite much needed infrastructure repairs along **Mission Street between Santa Marina and Cesar Chavez Streets**.

In spring 2014 the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission will install a new 8" water main pipe on **Mission Street between Santa Marina and Cesar Chavez Streets**. Water service will not be interrupted during installation of the new main. However, when water department crews make the final service connections overnight, water service will be temporarily interrupted. The water department will notify any affected residents in advance of overnight work. DPW will oversee the repaving of Mission St (curb to curb from Santa Marina to Cesar Chavez) once all the water department work has been completed.

Sidewalk and driveway access will be maintained at all times, although there may be temporary delays. Please allow extra travel time during construction.



**Impacts and Restrictions:** In order to expedite the work, maintain traffic lanes and accommodate bus zones, street parking will not be possible while construction occurs on a block. We apologize for this inconvenience and assure you we will restore street parking as soon as possible. Please see the posted barricade signs for exact work days, hours, and locations, because they may vary depending on the construction task.

Vehicles parked on the street during the posted work hours will be towed at the vehicle owner's expense. There will be no impact to MUNI bus lines during construction; however riders should allow extra time in the construction area. As construction nears, notices with more detail about traffic & parking challenges, construction schedule etc. will be sent out to residents and businesses.

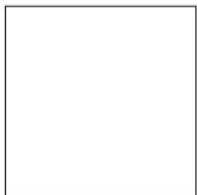
